




2. FOCUS GROUP The research Model

The Focus Group is a technique of social research, which has practical utility and ethical implications. It serves to deepen a theme or particular aspects of a topic, through an interview addressed to a homogeneous group of people.

The characteristic and potential of the Focus Group lies in the interaction that is created between the participants. An interaction that, if well done, is capable of generating ideas much more than the classical technique of the "face to face" interview or the questionnaire.










2. Useful indications for conducting the FOCUS GROUP

All the Focus Groups that have been organized have provided the presence of a **moderator** and an **observer**. T



he model used has provided the formulation of questions that have been proposed by the RSO and shared with all the partners. A **matrix** with the stimulus questions to be given to the participants has been drawn up.
